Product: StorNext[®] 2.7 build 92 and later running Solaris 10

Summary: When using lookup commands under managed directories, directory handles are shown rather than just the directory name

Date: September 2006

Problem: When using lookup commands like pwd, Solaris 10 systems will show directory names that include the directory handle, not just the directory name.

For Example: Changing directories to /stornext/hyperion1/1 and executing the pwd lookup command gives the following output:

This is caused by Solaris storing the directory handle in cache and then displaying it during lookup commands. This only affects directories that are managed by the StorNext Storage Manager. A modification to a Solaris kernel configuration file will stop this behavior.

Solution:

1 Add the following line (kernel global) to the /etc/system file:

set vfs_vnode_path = 0

2 Reboot the system.
